Marten Cornelis van den Berg Ministry of Foreign Affairs

Marten van den Berg is Director General Foreign Economic Relations at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the Netherlands.

Mr Van den Berg studied Economics at the Erasmus University in Rotterdam.

His first entry into public life was as senior policy advisor General Technology Policy

Ministry of Economic Affairs. In 1995 he was Deputy Chairman Working Group Technology Transfer, UNCTAD. In 1996 he was appointed to the Ministry of Economic Affairs as Adjunct Secretary General and from 1998 Deputy Director Spacial Economic Policy.

In 2001, mr Van den Berg was appointed Economic Minister at the Royal Netherlands Embassy in Washington.

In 2004 he returned at the Ministry of Economic Affairs as Deputy Director General Foreign Economic Relations and in 2008 he was also appointed Director Economic Diplomacy.

In 2012 the Directorate General for Foreign Economic Relations became part of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and since then he is as before acting as Deputy Director General Foreign Economic Relations.
